NCC Meeting Minutes:

February 13, 2018

Chairman Sharyl Ingham called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to the February meeting at the St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Oakland at 7:00 pm. She asked attendees for self-introductions; stating your name, where you live, and the year(s) of the Corvette(s) owned. The question of the evening was "What is your favorite donut?" Sharyl now knows which donuts are preferred for future Chapter meets.

The minutes of the January meeting were approved by the NCC Board as submitted by Secretary Sandy Houck.

Treasurer: John Tidwell

John reported that the NCC's treasury is solvent and mentioned meeting his goal for the Chapter to make a small net profit by year's end.

Membership: Sharyl Ingham

Sharyl reported that to date NCC has 82 members. She is still expecting more renewals but is happy about the steady growth of the membership.

Editor and Website: Marci Albers

The February Vettectera was published and distributed on the first of the month. Marci also reported that she has updated NCC's Homepage with the new mission as well as updating the event calendar.

NCRS President and Region IX Director: Mike Ingham

Mike had nothing to report other than mentioning the NCRS Board meeting in March.

Chapter Top Flight Award (CTFA): Jeff Blakeslee
In Jeff's absence Sharyl reported that NCC met all of the CTFA requirements and will receive recognition at the National Convention. And again, Sharyl subtly pushed people to write Tech articles for the newsletter.

Refreshment Coordinator: Rick Gower
Rick passed his Refreshment sign up sheet hoping to get someone to sign up for October's meeting.

Old Business:

Sharyl followed up with the members letting them know that she submitted NCC's Annual Report that included member comments about "what NCRS can do for the Chapter" and "what the Chapter sees as NCRS's priorities." She did say that she doesn't know what is done, if anything, once our comments are submitted.

New Business:

Meals on Wheels:

Sharyl passed out the letters with the \$100 check to the liaisons handling the delivery to the four counties: Alameda, Contra Costa, Solano, and Yolo for their

Meals on Wheels programs.

Chassis Tech Session, February 24th: Jeff Blakeslee
Jeff Blakeslee and Bill Cash are co-hosting the Tech Session at Jeff's house. They will review the chassis, engine and transmission of their early 1963 FI coupe. RSVPs are needed.

Suisun City Spring Meet, April 20-21: Dale Miller and Mike Ingham

Dale reported that there are already eight hotel reservations, saying it is still early and then that the registration went live on February 1st. Mike reported that six cars (a 1959, two-1963's, a 1966, a 1969, and a 1996) are registered to be flight judged, saying the car registrations are now closed. As a consequence, people will not be able to register for Sportsman. Mike made a plea to the members that we need more judges. Our Chapter is not alone being short of judges. That is the main reason we put in the disclaimer that we can only judge as many cars as we have judges. It is unfair to the owners if we don't have enough judges.

Proposed Road Tour: Ken Albers

Ken reported that the joint tour with North Bay Corvettes to Boatique in Kelseyville is tentatively scheduled for May 12. As far as he knows the North Bay Corvette Club may plan an overnight.

40th Anniversary, June 12:

Sharyl asked for ideas for the celebration, either at the regular Tuesday meeting or on a weekend. Sharyl hopes to have a sample shirt by the March meeting if not before. Perhaps at the Tech Session, some may get a glimpse. In any case, the idea is to sell them in Suisun City.

Fall Meet, October 5-6, Roseville:

Sharyl reported that a block of rooms under "NCC Corvette Club" is reserved at the Hampton Inn & Suites, 110 Sunrise Avenue, Roseville (telephone 916-772-9900) for a rate of \$119.

Break / Refreshments:

Glorie McNay drew name badges for three giveaways. The recipients were Don Mullenhoff, Art McNay, and John Tidwell. We thank Gary Miranda for providing the evening's refreshments.

Show and Tell:

Rick Gower showed a left side 1967 NOS hood latch assembly that he bought on eBay. Surprisingly the seller was Big City Corvettes in Livermore. Rick also brought the March issue of the Muscle Car Review Magazine featuring the 1967 Chevelle owned by NCC member Frank Rodriques.

Wayne Yurtin passed around a clock from a '63 asking if anyone might know something about it. The comments given were that the flange was damaged due probably to a bad repair. He also showed and

discussed the use of Calyx manifold dressing.

Chris Moore showed a detailed poster display of photos of 1963 Z06 master cylinder parts. He compared a master cylinder that's listed on eBay as NOS but probably a reproduction versus photos of an original master cylinder shown in the 1963 Z06 book. There are differences in the lettering and evidence of usage. This is very significant because the master cylinder is a very expensive item.

Gary Beaupre discussed his research into wheel weights that were used in the 60's. The most common weight is Micro which was made by Beta. A past employee of Beta told Gary that there were five companies that made wheel weights. Gary showed samples from Perfect Equipment, Speedclip made by Plumbium, and an unknown company which may be either Wheel Weights Inc. or a company called Salmon.

John Tidwell discussed a book that Rick Gower brought. It is "NCRS 1953 to 1972 Corvette Specifications Guide" that has part numbers and illustrations. For those collecting the set of Restorers, this is Vol. 16-1. John mentioned that Mike suggested that this guide should be reprinted and offered so John will take a look into getting that done.

Adjournment:

Sharyl adjourned the meeting at 8:05 PM by saying Live every moment, Laugh every day, and Love beyond words.

Now that you all have registered for the National Convention in Las Vegas and hopefully a road tour I'd like to pass on a few hints.

If you haven't registered yet please do so.

It takes an enormous amount of planning to put on a convention and it helps to have numbers of participants and working capital. Please register earlier than later, it is appreciated.

When you go to a motel or hotel evaluate those precious little toiletries. The shampoo will remove most spots that find clothing. If not to wash, a drop on the spot will be a stain removing agent when the garment is laundered. People have taken the trash can and added water and shampoo for a quick car wash, of course a hose must be available to rinse.

The conditioner is a great and works better than lotion on cuticles, just massage in, let sit for a few minutes then rinse with warm water..push cuticles back gently with wash cloth.

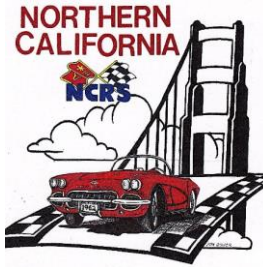
