space and a wise item to keep in the storage area. Also think wisely when deciding what to place on the sheet.

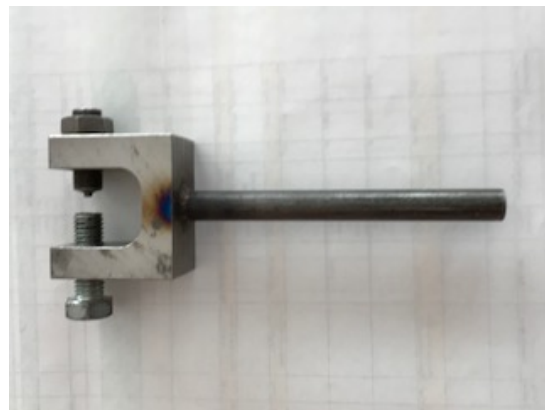
