NCRS President and Region IX Director: Mike Ingham

Mike reported that NCRS Board decided to cancel the Florida Regional Meet scheduled for February due to COVID safety concerns for attendees.

Old Business:

Rick Gower asked whether or not the Chapter made any donation to Meals on Wheels.

Sharyl reported that donations to Meals on Wheels were completed in February 2020.

New Business:

Good News From The DMV

Beginning December 6, 2020, drivers who are at least 70 years old can renew their drivers license online. This program applies to any license that expired beginning March 2020 and for the remainder of the COVID-19 pandemic. There is also expanded eligibility for online renewal for drivers 69 and younger. See the DMV website at www.dmv.ca.gov Thank you to Gary Hiltunen for making us aware of this.

NCRS Foundation Vehicle Donation Program

The NCRS Foundation is announcing its Vehicle Donation Program. This program has as its specific purpose to substantially grow the funds available for Foundation scholarships.

Each year the Foundation awards scholarships to college students who are relatives of NCRS Members. These scholarships are funded directly by donations from individual members, NCRS Chapters, NCRS Inc., and the silent auction and raffle fund raising activities at the National Convention. These actions raise

approximately \$40,000 each year. That amount basically limits the dollar amount and number of scholarships which the Foundation can grant annually. The Foundation's goal is to grow the program: e.g., to grant more individual scholarships and increase the amount of each grant.

The Foundation has defined and is now implementing a vehicle donation program to directly benefit the scholarship program by substantially increasing the funds available. The Foundation believes there are members or individuals who are in a position and have the desire to donate a vehicle for this purpose.

The following points explain the key aspects of the Foundation Vehicle Donation Program:

Why donate a vehicle to the NCRS Foundation?

- To directly benefit the Foundation Scholarship program.
- A donation to the Foundation (a 501c3 Tax exempt charity organization) may be advantageous to the individual's personal financial situation.
- To include such a donation in estate planning.

What make vehicles will the Foundation accept?

- While long-term the program may change, the Foundation will initially limit the Vehicle Donation Program to Corvettes.

What is required for a Corvette to be considered as a donation?

- Photos of the exterior, interior, engine compartment and chassis.
- A statement as to the Corvette's operational condition.
- A copy of the vehicle appraisal.

Will the Foundation sell the Corvettes donated?

- In general, the Foundation will sell the donated Corvette after three years.
- However, the Foundation expects to sell "driver quality" Corvettes in less than 3 years.
- All sales will be via auction.

What will the Foundation do with a donated Corvette prior selling it?

- It will be loaned to a 501c3 museum for display.

Chapter Meeting Location

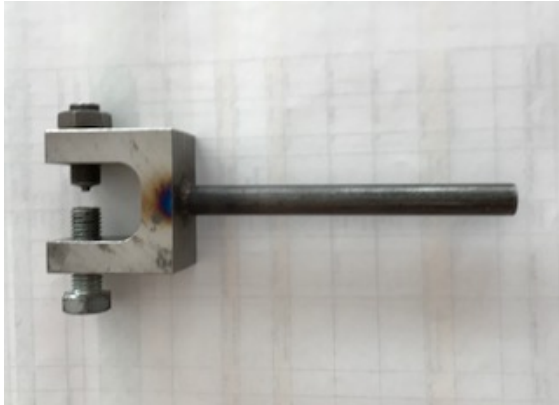
The location for Chapter meetings is at St. Peter's Episcopal Church located at 6013 Lawton Avenue, Oakland, CA 94618.
