Chairman Sharyl Ingham welcomed everyone to the February Zoom meeting at 7:00 pm. There were 28 attendees, including members from Alaska, Kansas, Laguna Woods, San Clemente, South Lake Tahoe, Washington, and Yorba Linda.

Sharyl asked for a moment of silence for all those that are no longer with us due to the global pandemic.

Before getting started Sharyl reminded us that this is a car club and not a public forum, and that one person should speak at a time.

As usual, Sharyl asked the attendees to introduce themselves, stating their name, the city where they live, and the year(s) of their Corvette(s). Sharyl's question of the evening was: How was your commute tonight? Since most of us are retired, the general response was "it's only a few feet and very easy."

Mike Ingham and John Tidwell started the meeting off addressing the COVID concerns about the Arizona Regional Meet in May. Neither could address whether there will be a quarantine period. At this point, Sharyl spoke as a member of the National Convention Team. The Team is doing its best to make changes in compliance with COVID restrictions and NCRS policies. She is working with Kristen Holmes on the welcome reception, judges' and tabulators' breakfasts and lunches, and the Awards Banquet. There will not be any buffet meals; all food will be served individually. Sharyl is also working with Dave Leash on the Event Clothing. There will be screened T-shirts and sweatshirts, and embroidered polo shirts and hats. There will be safety vests for Don Hooper's Trailer Parking Team, and for Dick Capello's Staging Team. New this year will be Fluorescent Armbands for Volunteers which are more cost-effective and easier to manage than T-shirts.


