April 14-15, 2023, Spring Judging Meet at Los Gatos, CA. I'd like to propose a dialog (and

Corvette C8 E-Ray update. I received a quote from the largest Bay Area Corvette dealership as follows: List is being created for both the hybrid Corvette and the all-electric Corvette. List inclusion costs \$10K. Hybrid price will be \$50K over MSRP at this dealership. All electric E Ray will be \$100K over MSRP at this dealership. They wanted potential buyers to know up front before they put down their \$10K list deposit. They feel these two versions will be in higher demand than the Z06. BTW-25,831 C8 Corvettes were produced in 2022. 52%/47% Coupes to Convertibles. Not bad considering that the plant has had some shutdowns. Welcome to the new Chevrolet!
