Covid Protocols:

Bob reviewed protocols for our events. Sharyl Ingham and Glorie McNay have sufficient mask and sanitizer supplies.

Judging Updates:

Mike Ingham noted that NCRS will start judging C6s next year.

<u>Chapter Top-Flight Award (CTFA)</u>: Jeff Blakeslee

Jeff was absent. He has asked Bob for help with the administrative tasks that CTFA requires. Barbara Vignone explained how she maintains a calendar and spreadsheet for the Southern California Chapter activities. Don Hooper reiterated the necessity of a good spreadsheet. The program is a way to increase participation and encourage technical articles, as well as to receive national NCRS recognition. Gene Love said he can do spreadsheets and offered to help. Thank you Gene!

New Business:

Jim Lockwood explained that it depends upon the type of seals and manufacturers.

Spring Meet, Los Gatos, April 14-15: Wayne Yurtin has everything all set with the Los Gatos Lodge. This will be a 5-point Judging Meet with judging on two days. Joe Calcagno will conduct a Tech Session on Friday. Wayne has arranged to have two race cars on display.
