NCC Meeting Minutes March 14, 2023

Chairman Bob Grauer welcomed 28 members to the March meeting at 7:00 pm via Zoom.

Bob started the meeting by announcing that John Tidwell has resigned as NCC Treasurer. He will remain as NCC Judging Co-Chair and NCRS National Treasurer. Bob expressed much appreciation to John for his years of service.

Bob talked with Chris Moore and he was willing to be the nominee for Treasurer. The NCC-NCRS Board of Directors unanimously selected Chris Moore to assume the position and responsibilities as Treasure for the Northern California Chapter of the National Corvette Restorers Society (NCC-NCRS) on March 14, 2023. Further, the board authorizes Chris as signer on the Chapter's Bank of America Checking account XXXXXX32012. As an authorized signer for NCC-NCRS, Chris will be authorized to sign checks, access bank balances, view transactions, stop payments and open/close accounts. This access is provided solely for the purpose of NCC-NCRS business transactions and may be revoked by the Board of Directors by vote.

At the meeting, Bob asked members to confirm the nomination. Chris was nominated by Bob and seconded by Wayne Yurtin. The members in attendance voted unanimously to elect Chris as NCC Treasurer.

<u>Secretary Report</u>: Sandy Houck The February minutes were approved by the Board.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: John Tidwell John will complete Treasurer duties for the March Tucson Regional Meet. <u>Membership</u>: Sharyl Ingham We currently have 109 paid members.

<u>Webmaster</u>: Chris Moore Chris was absent.

<u>Chapter Top-Flight Award (CTFA)</u>: Jeff Blakeslee

Jeff is calendaring potential events to meet the following CTFA activities.

- Membership in-person meetings: Being planned for June and November.
- Promote NCRS: We are considering a display booth at the August Goodguys West Coast Nationals. An indoor space would cost \$700 t0 \$1600. An option would be to display cars at a local show.
- Road Tour: Sandy Houck and Ken Albers will plan a drive to a Pope Valley winery in late early August or October.
- Charitable Donations: Sharyl Ingham coordinated with Meals on Wheels in Contra Costa County, Solano County, Yolo County, and East Bay Counties. We approved sending \$200 to each. The NCRS will match these donations.

New Business:

<u>NCRS Region IX Director and Vice-President</u>: Mike Ingham

Mike asked that any questions regarding the recent changes to the Board be sent to him. The Board is working with outside counsel to resolve issues. Mike expects to get back to normal activities of judging cars and working with NCRS members soon. Registrations for the National Convention in French Lick are doing very well.

<u>Tucson Regional Meet</u>: Mike Ingham So far there are 122 registrations, 22 cars for judging, and about 200 people expected to attend.

<u>NCC Spring Meet, Los Gatos</u>: Mike Ingham and Wayne Yurtin

Wayne has arranged for a party bus to take attendees to dinner on Friday so that you can leave your cars at the hotel. Security for cars will be provided. So far there are 27 registrations, and cars to the judged range from '58 to '71.

<u>NCC Fall Meet, Sonora</u>: Jerry Fuccillo and Sharyl Ingham

Jerry and Sharyl reviewed the Heritage Inn hotel proposal for September 22 & 23. Jerry is completing details, including car security. <u>Corvette and other car News</u>: Bob Grauer Bob reported that there will be an all-Corvette auction at a Houston museum in conjunction with the April Mecum Auction.

Bob recommended watching the Motor Trend TV Engine Masters episodes. Lots of good old school tuning info. John Tidwell is also a fan of the series.

<u>Technical Discussion Board</u>: Gary Beaupre and Rick Gower

Rick said that a current hot topic is Corey Peterson's discussion of the first '53, Corvette 001. See the fourth part on YouTube.

The Board's Townhall meeting is getting a lot of attention.
