Jeff Blakeslee's tech session on gasoline / ethanol / octane / and vapor was not as well attended as we had hoped due to the short notice. Everyone who attended was not disappointed at all. The presentation was terrific. The Q&A (especially) answered age

old questions why engines either fail to start easily or eagerly run dependent on gasoline blend and season. I asked Jeff to replay his demonstration at Sonora. Stand by! Examples - Jeff DIY'd test equipment that anyone can adopt to test the vaporization characteristics of available fuel.
