

Spring Meet, San Rafael: Sharyl reported that Embassy Suites will not allow us to bring in food from the outside. She will review the menus and costs. Dinner will be at the Red Oak at the hotel.

Possible 2028 Regional Meet with SoCal and CCC: Beverly LeGate will visit the San Rafael venue along with Jeff and Sharyl.

New Business

Swap Meet: Jeff will email members and ask how many are interested.

Calendar Update: Jeff and Sharyl will review our calendar dates so as to not conflict with nearby Chapter or Regional events.

The Board Meeting adjourned at 6:58 pm.

NCC General Meeting Minutes – February 10, 2026

Chairman Jeff Blakeslee called the Meeting to order at 7:00 pm and welcomed 27 members. He asked us to introduce ourselves stating where we live and the Corvette(s) we own.

Technical Discussion Board

Rick Gower reported there have been many posts about 3-point vs. 5-point meets. He also recommends reading the Sticky section to see updates from the Judging Chairman. Finally, the Solid Axle Club is dismantling.

Bob Grauer's half-shaft and drive shaft replacement.

Bob described removing the driveshaft and halfshafts on his '69. They were very rusty with leaking U-joints. He felt it was a safety issue, so he installed new parts purchased from Corvette Central. He claimed that the project was not difficult since he has a car lift. Mark Pellowski added pictures of his replaced drivetrain.

Gary and Jeff's throttle bushing progress.

Last month Jeff Blakeslee and Gary Beaupre described making the bushing with a 3D resin printer. Jeff explained how the printer works and that the resin is cured with UV light. He seems to be in production now having made about 40 bushings. The process is time consuming because a lot of cleanup is required.

My Favorite Tool

Jeff wants to start this new segment, and asked us: What is your favorite specialty or maintenance tool? Dave Stashik said it was his torque wrench. Dave Houlihan showed a picture of a tool he made to check spark plug connections. Ken Albers likes his 2-post lift. Kingston Wulff apparently drops things since he likes the extendable rod with a magnet. Jeff Blakeslee described the AirLift pump for removing fluid and refilling a radiator. Bring your favorite tools to the next meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 8:20 pm.


